We provide professional counseling, social work, and emergency aid to individuals, families and groups.

AdoptionLinks

AdoptionLinks assists couples and individuals in achieving the goal of building a family through adoption and foster-to-adopt programs. We also provide support services that encourage and reinforce family life through educational, therapeutic, mentoring and support group opportunities for all members of the adoptive family.

Counseling

The counseling program helps individuals and families deal with the stresses and inevitable challenges of life. Licensed therapists provide group, couples, individual and children's counseling. If clients do not have insurance coverage, JFS offers a reduced sliding scale fee for services.

Mynd Works

Mynd Works is a therapeutic center for children and young adults ages 2-21 facing a variety of learning and emotional/behavioral challenges. The clinic provides a unique set of treatments, occupational therapy and children's counseling, including play therapy and support groups.

Senior Services

JFS assists elderly and disabled citizens by offering a broad range of services, including counseling, care and case management, power of attorney, legal guardianship, referral and advocacy services. We also deliver almost 3,500 meals a year for our Kosher Meals on Wheels program. Our goal is to help seniors reach and maintain their optimum level of functioning, prevent inappropriate institutional placement and maintain self-sufficiency for as long as possible.

Temple Grandin to Speak in Harrisburg

Jewish Family Service Hosts World Renowned Author and Speaker on Autism

Noted author and animal behaviorist, Temple Grandin, Ph.D., will be the featured speaker at a fundraising event for Jewish Family Service of Greater Harrisburg to be held on May 23, 2010 at the Zembo Shrine in Harrisburg. Dr. Grandin will speak about growing up in the 1950's as a child with autism, an experience she describes as "thinking in pictures."

Dr. Grandin is inarguably the most accomplished and well-known adult with autism in the world. She has been featured on major television programs such as "Primetime Live," the "Today Show," "Larry King Live," "48 Hours" and "20/20," and been highlighted in national publications such as *Time*, *People*, *Forbes*, *U.S. News and World Report*, and *The New York Times*. A television movie based on her life, starring Claire Danes, is set to premiere on HBO in the Spring of 2010.

Mute until she was three and a half years old, Dr. Grandin communicated her frustration by screaming, peeping and humming. Her parents were told she should be institutionalized. She tells her story of "groping her way from the far side of darkness" in her book *Emergence: Labeled Autistic*, a book which stunned the world because, until its publication, most professionals and parents assumed being diagnosed "autistic" was virtually a death sentence to achievement or productivity in life.

Dr. Grandin has become a prominent author and speaker on the subject of autism because "I have read enough to know that there are still many parents, and, yes, professionals, too, who believe that 'once autistic, always autistic.' This dictum has meant sad and sorry lives for many children diagnosed, as I was in early life, as autistic. To these people, it is incomprehensible that the characteristics of autism can be modified and controlled. However, I feel strongly that I am living proof that they can."

Even though she was considered "weird" in her young school years, she eventually found a mentor, who recognized her interests and abilities. Dr. Grandin obtained her B.A. at Franklin Pierce College, her M.S. in Animal Science at Arizona State University, and her Ph.D. in Animal Science from the University of Illinois. Today she teaches courses on livestock behavior and facility design at Colorado State University. She also speaks around the world on autism, cattle handling, and animal welfare.

Dr. Grandin's current bestseller is *The Way I See It*. Her other work includes *Animals Make us Human*, *Animals in Translation* (both *New York Times* best sellers), *Unwritten Rules of Social Relationships*, *Thinking in Pictures and Other Reports From My Life With Autism*, and *Emergence: Labeled Autistic*.

Jewish Family Service of Greater Harrisburg is a not-for-profit human services agency dedicated to preserving and strengthening the quality of life for individuals and families, regardless of faith or background. Now in their 46th year, they have provided social services to the Greater Harrisburg community – from children's, marital and family counseling to adoption/foster care placement, geriatric care management, and the Mynd Works clinic for children with special needs.
