### **MY HERO BROTHER WAS A BIG HIT!**

Even the Steelers-Patriots' AFC Championship match-up couldn't keep some 120 members of our community away on the 22nd of January, when the Harrisburg Jewish Film Festival and Jewish Family Service partnered to present the Israeli documentary, *My Hero Brother* at the JCC.

Directed and co-produced by Israeli filmmaker Yonatan Nir, *My Hero Brother* recounts a walking trek undertaken by eleven pairs of siblings - one of whom, in each pair, was born with Down syndrome - up a mountain in the Himalayas.

Nir was in attendance to introduce the picture, and remained afterwards to answer questions about the physical and emotional challenges of the journey for all of its participants. Highlighted in the film and discussion were the complicated dynamics between special needs adults and the siblings who grew up in their shadows, as well as the excursion's role in opening the eyes and hearts of the siblings to a new appreciation of their uniquely open-hearted brothers and sisters with Down syndrome.



Both the film and Yonatan Nir were received most enthusiastically, as was Norman Gras's delicious "hints of India" pre-screening reception.
