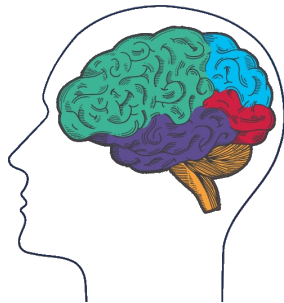
Drugs 101: What Parents & Kids Need to Know
